

Junior WARRIBALD 2020

WAG and WDEA Works invite entries to the Junior Warrnibald Prize 2020 – a portrait competition, just like The Warrnibald Prize, but for artists aged 18 and under

Artists can submit a portrait of anyone in their lives who they look up to. The subject must know and have a relationship with the artist, for example the artist's subject could be a parent, a grandparent, a foster carer, a neighbour, a friend, a teacher, a doctor, a nurse, or a shop owner

Portraits will be exhibited in a virtual exhibition online

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All entrants must comply with the following entry instructions and conditions

Eligibility

Entries to the Junior Warrnibald Prize 2020 must be by artists aged 18 and under

Key dates

Artworks must be submitted by 5pm Friday 26 June 2020

Online exhibition opens on 26 June 2020 to Sunday 12 July 2020 on the WAG website

Winners will be announced at a live online special event 1-2pm on Sunday 12 July 2020

Making and Submitting your Portrait

- One artwork only per entrant
- Can be vertical or horizontal
- Any art materials or combination of art materials may be used
- The artwork must be two-dimensional
- Artwork must not be self-portraits
- The artwork must be photographed and submitted as a digital file saved as a JPG no larger than 5 megabytes in file size
- Fill in and submit the entry form online ensuring that a parent or legal guardian has signed permission for entry

An Explore, Learn, Create – from Home resource can be downloaded from the WAG website. This can be used to help you learn more about portraits and explore some of the portraits in WAG's Collection. Then use your own imagination and creativity to make your own portrait of someone who inspires you

Tips for photographing artworks

- Place the artwork on or against a white paper or neutral background
- Photograph it in an area where there is plenty of natural light. Soft, diffused light is better than direct sunlight
- Make sure your artwork is in focus

PRIZES

Entrants will be eligible to receive a prize in the artist's age group. First and second prizes will be awarded in five age groups:

- Up to age 5
- Ages 6-8
- Ages 9-11
- Ages 12-15
- Ages 16-18

First prize winners in each age group will receive a cash prize of \$100. Second prize winners in each age group will receive a Darrian Office Choice Art Gift Voucher valued at \$50

A special prize will also be awarded to one artist whose work displays outstanding creativity. This winner will receive a cash prize of \$100 and the opportunity to work with a local graphic designer to create a children's mascot for WAG

JUDGING CRITERIA

Entries will be judged by a selected panel according to the following criteria:

- The relevance of the submitted artwork to the theme, as decided by the judges
- Artistic interpretation of the theme, as decided by the judges
- The originality of the submission

Judges will be announced on or before 26 June 2020

Terms and conditions

- Entry is open to all children currently living in South West Victoria aged under 18 years
- The subject must know and have a relationship with the artist,
- Images of the subject may be obtained directly (i.e. in-person sketches made by the artist or from photographs taken by the artist) as well as photographs supplied directly by the subject at the request of the artist for the purpose of creating their portrait.
- Artwork submitted must be the original work of the entrant themselves and not infringe the copyright, moral rights or other rights of any third party. This means you must not copy an artwork or photograph created by another person or an image from another source such as the internet or a print publication unless provided by the subject for the purpose of creating their portrait
- Artworks that are deemed not to belong to or be created by the entrant will NOT be eligible
- Artwork containing photography of children is not permitted
- Licensing the artwork: Entrants grant the Gallery non-exclusive rights to reproduce their artwork in material form, to photograph, publish and/or communicate it to the public for the following project-related purposes, and anything incidental to such purposes, by the Gallery, its project partners and sponsors: marketing, publicity, educational and publication uses for the Gallery, the competition and its exhibition in all media, including but not limited to electronic/digital, broadcasting and print media in perpetuity
- As partners in this project, the licensing permission extends to the WDEA Works, who may wish to reproduce artworks via their communication channels

- Permission to so reproduce the work must be conveyed by the entrant to any purchaser of the work. Where reasonable, the Gallery will attribute the artists as the author of the work and reproduce the work in full
- Details of the work may be used at the Gallery's discretion
- Entrants will not be entitled to any fee for such use
- No three-dimensional artworks will be accepted
- Children of WAG and WDEA Works employees and volunteers are permitted to enter but are ineligible to receive any prizes
- Prizes cannot be transferred. Gift cards will be given to a parent or guardian, who may be asked to sign the card. Non-cash prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.
- In the event that for any reason whatsoever a finalist/winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the Gallery then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the finalist/winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize
- The Gallery shall endeavour to contact the finalists by email within one day of the prize judging
