

JuniorWARRNIBALD2022

WAG and WDEA Works invite entries to the Junior Warrnibald Prize 2022 – a portrait competition, just like The Warrnibald Prize, but for artists aged 18 and under

Artists can submit a portrait of anyone in their lives who they look up to. The subject must know and have a relationship with the artist, for example the artist's subject could be a parent, a grandparent, a foster carer, a neighbour, a friend, a teacher, a doctor, a nurse, or a shop owner

Pick up your frame from the Gallery and create your portrait either at WAG or at home, and return before 3pm Friday 15 July.

Portraits will be exhibited at WAG between 2 to 17 July 2022. Junior Prize-winning works will be included in the Warrnibald Prize 2022 exhibition.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All entrants must comply with the following entry instructions and conditions

Eligibility

Entries to the Junior Warrnibald Prize 2022 must be by artists under the age of 18

Key dates

- The Junior Warrnibald will open 10am Saturday 2 July and close 3pm Sunday 17 July 2022
- Artworks must be delivered by 3pm Friday 15 July 2022
- Prize winners will be announced at WAG from 1-2pm on Sunday 17 July 2022

Making and Submitting your Portrait

- One artwork only per entrant
- Can be vertical or horizontal
- Any art materials or combination of art materials may be used
- The artwork must be two-dimensional
- Artwork must not be self-portraits
- Fill in and submit the entry form on page 4 ensuring that a parent or legal guardian has signed permission for entry. Entry forms are available for download via the WAG website or in person at WAG reception 26 Liebig Street
- Specially-designed Junior Warrnibald art boards can be collected from WAG from 20 June 2022
- Artworks can be created at WAG between 2 to 15 July 2022. Please note gallery hours are 10am-5pm Mon-Fri and 10am-3pm Sat-Sun
- Alternatively, artworks can be created anywhere so long as they're delivered by 3pm Friday 15 July 2022

An Explore, Learn, Create – from Home resource can be downloaded from the WAG website. This can be used to help you learn more about portraits and explore some of the portraits in WAG's Collection. Then use your own imagination and creativity to make your own portrait of someone who inspires you

PRIZES

Entrants will be eligible to receive a prize in the artist's age group. First and second prizes will be awarded in five age groups:

- Up to age 5
- Ages 6-8
- Ages 9-11
- Ages 12-15
- Ages 16-18

First prize winners in each age group will receive a cash prize of \$100. Second prize winners in each age group will receive a Darrian Office Choice Art Gift Voucher valued at \$50

A special prize will also be awarded to one artist whose work displays outstanding creativity. This winner will receive a cash prize of \$100.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Entries will be judged by an art industry leader according to the following criteria:

- The relevance of the submitted artwork to the theme, as decided by the judges
- Artistic interpretation of the theme, as decided by the judges
- The originality of the submission

Judges will be announced on or before 2 July 2022

Terms and conditions

- Entry is open to all children currently living in South West Victoria aged under 18 years
- The subject must know and have a relationship with the artist,
- Images of the subject may be obtained directly (i.e. in-person sketches made by the artist or from photographs taken by the artist) as well as photographs supplied directly by the subject at the request of the artist for the purpose of creating their portrait.
- Artwork submitted must be the original work of the entrant themselves and not infringe the copyright, moral rights or other rights of any third party. This means you must not copy an artwork or photograph created by another person or an image from another source such as the internet or a print publication unless provided by the subject for the purpose of creating their portrait
- All entries **must be made on the Warrnambool Art Gallery's specially-designed Junior Warrnibald art board.**
- Artworks that are deemed not to belong to or be created by the entrant will NOT be eligible
- Artwork containing photography of children is not permitted
- Licensing the artwork: Entrants grant the Gallery non-exclusive rights to reproduce their artwork in material form, to photograph, publish and/or communicate it to the public for the following project related purposes, and anything incidental to such purposes, by the Gallery, its project partners and sponsors: marketing, publicity, educational and publication uses for the Gallery, the competition and its exhibition in all media, including but not limited to electronic/digital, broadcasting and print media in perpetuity
- As partners in this project, the licensing permission extends to the WDEA Works, who may wish to reproduce artworks via their communication channels
- Permission to so reproduce the work must be conveyed by the entrant to any purchaser of the work. Where reasonable, the Gallery will attribute the artists as the author of the work and reproduce the work in full
- Details of the work may be used at the Gallery's discretion
- Entrants will not be entitled to any fee for such use
- No three-dimensional artworks will be accepted
- Children of WAG and WDEA Works employees and volunteers are permitted to enter but are ineligible to receive any prizes
- Prizes cannot be transferred. Gift cards will be given to a parent or guardian, who may be asked to sign the card. Non-cash prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.
- In the event that for any reason whatsoever a finalist/winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the Gallery then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the finalist/winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize
- The Gallery shall endeavour to contact the finalists by email within one day of the prize judging
- Entries must be accompanied by a completed Artist Entry Form (page 4), including a signature of entry approval from a parent or guardian. See WAG Privacy Statement at the end of this document.
- **Entries must state the artist's name, age and name of sitter on the front of the work;**

WAG reserves the right to cancel or postpone any associated public events in response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic. WAG will announce any changes via our website and social media channels.
